

Infant / Toddler Teacher

The Infant/Toddler Teacher is responsible for maintaining the safety, management, and well being of the infant/toddler classroom and the children enrolled in the infant/toddler class. She reports to the Early Childhood Director.

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring the safety and wellbeing of the children in your care and making sure the classroom and play space is free of hazards, meets all licensing requirements, and provides adequate opportunities for all children to explore and learn.
- Develop weekly lesson plans that are provide ample opportunities for each child to learn, explore, grow, and develop, according to his/her individual needs
- Keep excellent communication with parents and other staff members to make sure the child's needs are clearly communicated, the child's needs are met, and that the child receives the care he/she needs for optimal development
- Have a positive and nurturing demeanor and create a positive and nurturing classroom environment
- Modeling the Christian faith, promoting professionalism, and acting with compassion in all aspects of the job, personal life, and relationships with staff, students, and families.

Requirements:

- A high school diploma or GED
- A minimum of 2 years experience in early childhood education, preferably working with infants and toddlers
- Ability to appropriately communicate with young children and families.
- Desire to work with a team
- Trained in CPR and First Aid
- Ability to pass a state background check
- Willingness to grow spiritually and professionally
